- Edit to 1 minute long maximum.
- After the event submission window closes, you must be willing to supply raw video to Still Frothy for a video edit

- You must post your video to your own social media channels (Instagram or Facebook only)

- Enter within your specific division based on age as of October 21, 2020 (we may request your birthdate) :
 - Pro AM (\$1,000 for winner)
 - Boys Junior 15-17 (Prize amount TBD)
 - Girls 17 and under (Prize amount TBD)
 - Boys 12 and under (Prize amount TBD)
 - 10 and under mixed (Prize amount TBD)

Judging Criteria

We realize that judging videos is a bit more of a challenge and a new endeavor for Still Frothy, but in the end, the surfing always wins. Video production quality is welcomed and part of the criteria, but by itself will not get you the win. For us, it will always come down to the quality and progression of the surfing. Please do your best to hit on the following marks:

- Criticality of the maneuvers
- Variety of maneuvers
- Assume it's a standard competition scenario, so we are looking for combinations and progressive surfing
- It's the surfing, not the waves
- Judging panel will be a mix of judges from different regions (Ventura to SLO County)
